<b>1. Apologies</b>

<b>2. Minutes of the last meeting</b>	
There were no matters arising.	
<b>3. Site / Operation update</b>	
JH reported that site operations were going well with no issues to report. The Environment Agency visited with site on 13 April 2022 and a subsequent report was received to confirm that there were no issues on site and no odour issues had been reported to the EA.  JH reported that no direct complaints has been received regarding odours or litter in relation to the site.	
<b>4. Planning applications</b>	
JH advised that Wiltshire Council are considering the implementation of a kerbside collection of household batteries, such as those found in toys or mobile devices, and the collection of small domestic appliances (WEEE and SDA). These types of waste require separate storage containers to allow for each load collected from households to be bulked to a suitable scale for reprocessors to then collect for recycling.  In order to facilitate this a planning application has been submitted to vary condition 3 of the 2018 consent to allow such items to be stored outside of the building in secure containers.
